Adults: Internally Driven Initiatives

- ◆ **Backpack Food Ministries** St. Luke's collects, organizes, and delivers donations of food for underserved families whose children attend a local elementary school.
- ◆ **Disaster Relief** St. Luke's supports disaster relief efforts by donating emergency supplies and funds as requested when a disaster occurs. In addition, teams often travel to disaster sites to deliver donations and provide physical assistance and spiritual support.

Adults: Externally Driven Organizations

- ◆ **Honduras Good Works** is a faith-based non-profit that sponsors health care mission trips to Honduras, as well as education for underserved Honduran youth through scholarships.
- ◆ **Refugee Services of Texas** is a non-profit in partnership with Episcopal Migration Ministries and other faith-based groups that helps resettle and support legal immigrant families as they transition into life in the United States.
- ◆ **Special project partnering with Armadillo RV park**

Children & Youth

- ◆ **Middle School Mission Trip [6th – 8th grade]/High School Mission Trip [9th – 12th grade]** Youth spend 7-10 days [MS within Texas, HS outside Texas] to provide support to underserved people in a variety of ways, including preparation/organization/distribution of food/clothing/supplies, leading VBS-style programs for children, doing home cleanup/repair, praying for and with people and many others.
- ◆ **Family Mission Trip [infants – adults]**
