Adults: Internally Driven Initiatives

- Backpack Food Ministries St. Luke's collects, organizes, and delivers donations of food for underserved families whose children attend a local elementary school.
- **Disaster Relief** St. Luke's supports disaster relief efforts by donating emergency supplies and funds as requested when a disaster occurs. In addition, teams often travel to disaster sites to deliver donations and provide physical assistance and spiritual support.
