**WORSHIP** *Gather in community weekly to thank, praise, & dwell with God*

**Adults**

- ◆ **Altar Guild** is responsible for setting up all altar items before and cleaning up after worship services.
- ◆ **Choir** sings at 10:15 AM Sunday services and other special services.
- ◆ **Eucharistic Ministers** assist the priests with distribution of wine and bread at worship services.
- ◆ **Eucharistic Visitors** make pastoral visits and serve Holy Eucharist to members who are hospitalized, shut-in, or otherwise unable to attend worship services.
- ◆ **Floral Guild** selects, purchases and arranges altar flowers for worship services, then packages them for delivery to homebound, hospitalized, or grieving parishioners.
- ◆ **Greeters** warmly welcome guests and members, answer questions, and give directions.
- ◆ **Lectors** read the Bible lessons appointed for the worship service aloud to the congregation.
- ◆ **Ushers** assist guests and members with bulletins, traffic flow, seating and directions, and help with offering collection, head count, visitor cards, and clean-up.
- ◆ **Worship Technology** sets up/takes down audio/visual equipment, runs worship projection software, and operates the soundboard.

**Children & Youth** [*"Safeguarding God's Children" abuse prevention certification required*]

- ◆ **Acolytes [4<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade]** assist in worship by carrying a processional cross, lighting candles, holding the Gospel book, holding candles or "torches", assisting the priest at the altar, handing the offering plates to ushers, and other tasks.
