## **LEARN** Go deeper & learn about your faith with a focus on Jesus' life & teachings

#### **Adults**

- Sunday Morning Clergy Forum Join our clergy and special guests for interactive conversations centered on the Bible readings of the week, or other special topics.
- ♦ The Art of Engaging Holy Scripture (TAEHS) TAEHS is a form of *Lectio Divina* [Latin for "Divine Reading"], a a traditional Benedictine practice of scriptural reading, meditation, and prayer intended to promote communion with God and to increase the knowledge of God's Word.
- ♦ Martha Guild Meet with working women monthly on Saturday morning for a book or Bible study.
- St. Luke's Women's Guild Meet with other women at St. Luke's monthly for a book or Bible study.
- ◆ **Small Groups** Join a small group to participate in facilitated Bible studies.

#### Children & Youth

- Godly Play [Infants 4yrs] Children learn about God and his love and care for them through ageappropriate interactive play with specially trained teachers.
- ◆ The Island [Kinder 5<sup>th</sup> grade] Children learn Bible points in a fun, interactive way through art, drama, cooking, science, and other modes.
- ♦ Middle School Class [6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade] Youth study the Bible readings of the week through hands-on activities, object lessons, and journaling.
- Faith Discovery: A Youth Confirmation Preparation Class [8<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> grade] Youth examine all that we believe, ask hard questions, struggle with how it lines up with one's personal beliefs, and learn how that faith is expressed in the Episcopal Church.
- High School Class [9<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grade] Youth delve deeper into the Bible readings of the week through
  rhetorical discussion and debate, with seasonal and special studies sprinkled in for good measure.
- ◆ Episcopal Youth Community [EYC] [6<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> grade]/Pre-EYC [3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grade] Students participate in Bible studies facilitated by our Youth Director and assistants.
- ♦ Vacation Bible School [Infants 5<sup>th</sup> grade] Children learn Bible points through drama, music play, art, science, and small group conversations with adult and youth leaders.

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#### Adults

**Children & Youth** ["Safeguarding God's Children" abuse prevention certification required]

- Godly Play [Infants 4yrs] Help our Nursery staff care for our youngest members and guests as they learn about God from specially trained teachers.
- ◆ The Island [Kinder 5<sup>th</sup> grade] Serve as a leader, assistant, or substitute in one of our learning stations, which involve the use of art, drama, cooking, science, and other modes to teach our Bible points; curriculum and support is provided.
- ◆ Middle School Class [6<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> grade] Serve as a substitute.
- ◆ Faith Discovery: A Youth Confirmation Preparation Class [8<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> grade] Serve as a substitute.
- ♦ **High School Class [9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade]** Serve as a substitute.
- Episcopal Youth Community [EYC] [6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade]/Pre-EYC [3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grade] Serve as an assistant during regular Sunday evening meetings and/or special events.
- Vacation Bible School [Infants 5<sup>th</sup> grade] Serve as a leader or assistant for a station or a small group of children; prepare materials in advance.
